Mongolia bird flu fears ease

AN outbreak of avian flu in Mongolia seems to have died out quickly on its own, experts said, raising questions about how easily migrating birds will spread the virus.

They said only about 100 birds seemed to have succumbed to the virus in an outbreak at Erkhel Lake, near where the borders of Russia, China and Mongolia meet.
